

Chief of Army Staff General Wakar-Uz-Zaman called on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus

Chief of Army Staff General Wakar-Uz-Zaman called on Chief Adviser Professor Muhammad Yunus on Monday. During the meeting, the Chief Adviser discussed the army's role in assisting the civil administration under the present circumstances.
