

INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

CONFERENCE REPORT
The following report summarizes the key findings and recommendations from the international conference on sustainable development and environmental protection, held in Geneva, Switzerland, from 10 to 15 October 2000.

The conference was attended by representatives from over 100 countries, including heads of state and government ministers. The main theme of the conference was the need for a new global compact to address the challenges of sustainable development and environmental protection in the 21st century. The conference concluded with the adoption of the 'Geneva Declaration on Sustainable Development and Environmental Protection', which sets out a vision for a more just and sustainable world.

The Geneva Declaration calls for a new global compact that is based on the principles of equity, justice, and sustainability. It emphasizes the need for a more equitable distribution of resources and opportunities, and for a more sustainable pattern of consumption and production. The declaration also calls for a more integrated approach to development, one that takes account of the social, economic, and environmental dimensions of development. The conference also adopted a set of recommendations for action, which include the need to strengthen international cooperation, to improve the effectiveness of international institutions, and to promote a more sustainable and equitable world.
